- facilitates the selection, acquisition, installation, and training associated with the **New Work Technologies** to be incorporated into each New Work Center.
- ensures the **integration** of New Work Technologies and local interests and desires to create an effective self-providing community.

What Are New Work Technologies?

What makes any technology a “New Work” technology is its ability to contribute to an **independent, self-providing**, and enhanced quality of life for a community. Examples include:

- Fast, low-cost construction techniques (from prefabricated blocks to dome construction).
- Self-powered electrical generation technology (from diesel to wind to thin-film solar panels).
- Cooking, refrigeration, washing machines, air conditioning, and other domestic machinery.
- Computers, multimedia labs, Internet access, etc. (a “New Work Cafe”).
- Transportation (from self-made automobiles, to lighter-than-air vehicles).
- Micro-factories for local production (e.g., cement).
- Decentralized, mobile micro-manufacturing facilities.
- Permaculture gardens and farming.
- Compostable toilets.
- Waste water recycling equipment.
